We are currently accepting referrals for clients who require a collaborative multidisciplinary approach from one or more of our allied health services in the following region/communities of the Northern Territory.

Please note that our referral acceptance criteria will be changed depending on the skills, experience, and preferences for our speech therapists, physiotherapists, and occupational therapists travelling to a regional/remote or very remote area.

Please note that all referrals received are triaged to determine urgency of need to see your client. The more information that is provided in the referral, the easier it is for us to process your referral. Please speak to our client co-ordination team for more information.
